



Guidance Update



- All seniors need to complete the following: FERPA, resume, essay, compile a list of 5-7 colleges of interest, and request letters of recommendation from 2-3 teachers. In addition to requesting your recommendation letters through Naviance, please request your letters from the teachers in person. Many will require a resume to be sent to them upon completion.
 - **FAFSA application parent meeting - November 17th at 6pm** - seniors and their parents are invited to attend a meeting facilitated by a Siena College representative, who will review the process of applying for FAFSA.
 - When applying to schools, please ensure you pick the appropriate application deadline (the dates listed are not exact for all colleges)
 - **Early Decision:** October-December 15; binding application
 - **Early Action:** November 15-January 15; non-binding application
 - **Regular Admissions:** January 1-March 1; non-binding application
 - **Rolling Admissions:** Some colleges accept students as applications are submitted.
 - **INSTANT ADMISSION DAY-HVCC - December 2nd - 10am-2pm**
 - **SAT registration:** <https://www.collegeboard.org>. Please register if you have not taken your SAT's. Some schools will require SAT scores to be reported as part of their application process. Some are test optional for students starting Fall 2023.
 - **Sending SAT Scores**
 1. Sign in to your College Board account, then go to the Send SAT Scores page. On the Send SAT Scores page, you might get a prompt about fee waivers.
 2. Select colleges to send scores to. Search for colleges by name or code.
 3. For each recipient, send all scores or only some of your scores. Review your order.
 - Ongoing communication regarding college visits and college fairs will be announced in the weekly newsletter.


